**Subject: Adverse weather over northwest India on 4<sup>th</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup> February, 2017**

An active western disturbance is most likely to affect western Himalayan region from today, the 2<sup>nd</sup> February night to 6<sup>th</sup> February morning and plains of northwest India on 4<sup>th</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup> February 2017. Details of the expected weather are given below:

- Light to moderate rainfall/snowfall is most likely to occur over western Himalayan region till 4<sup>th</sup> morning. There will be increase in intensity & spread thereafter with fairly widespread to widespread rain/snowfall activity over Jammu & Kashmir, Himachal Pradesh and Uttarakhand on 4<sup>th</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup> February.
- Light to moderate scattered rain/thundershower is very likely to occur over Punjab, Haryana, Chandigarh & Delhi and isolated rainfall activity over north Rajasthan & West Uttar Pradesh on 4<sup>th</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup> February.

**Warning:**

**a. Heavy snowfall warning**

- Isolated heavy to very heavy rainfall/snowfall is most likely to occur over Jammu & Kashmir and isolated heavy rainfall/snowfall over Himachal Pradesh on 4<sup>th</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup> February.

**b. Hailstorm warning**

- Hailstorm at isolated pockets is very likely over Punjab and Haryana on 4<sup>th</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup> February.
