Subject: Southwest Monsoon advanced over NCR Delhi

Today, the southwest monsoon has further advanced into some more parts of Rajasthan and Himachal Pradesh, remaining parts of Madhya Pradesh, Uttar Pradesh and Uttarakhand, entire National Capital region NCR (Delhi) and some parts of Haryana.

The Northern Limit of Monsoon (NLM) passes through Lat. 26.0 °N / Long. 70.0°E, Barmer, Sikar, Sonipat, Shimla, Dharmshala, Baderwah, Pahalgam and Lat.35.0°N / Long. 74.0°E. The map of southwest monsoon advance 2017 is given on page 2.

Forecast:

Fairly widespread to widespread rainfall very likely over northwest India including NCR Delhi during next 24 hours and decrease in intensity and spatial distribution thereafter outside East Rajasthan, Uttar Pradesh and Uttarakhand where it is very likely to continue for another 3-4 days.

Warnings:

Heavy rain very likely at isolated places over East Rajasthan during next 24 hours; and over Uttarakhand and Uttar Pradesh during next 3-4 days.
