



All India Weather Warning Bulletin

Monday 19 November 2018
Time of Issue: 1630 Hours IST

(EVENING)

19 November (Day 1): ♦ Heavy rain very likely at isolated places over coastal Tamilnadu & Puducherry.

♦ Squally winds speed reaching 45-55 kmph gusting to 65 kmph is very likely to prevail over central parts of south Arabian Sea. Sea condition is very likely to be rough to very rough over these areas. Fishermen are advised not to venture into the above mentioned areas.

♦ Squally winds 35-45 kmph gusting to 55 kmph is likely to prevail over Southwest Bay of Bengal and adjoining Equatorial India Ocean. Sea condition is very likely to be rough to very rough over these areas. Fishermen are advised not to venture into the above mentioned areas.

♦ **Thunderstorm accompanied with gusty wind & lighting** at isolated places very likely over south Madhya Maharashtra and south Konkan & Goa.

20 November (Day 2): ♦ Heavy rain at a few places with very heavy falls at isolated places very likely over Tamilnadu & Puducherry and **isolated heavy** over South Interior Karnataka.

♦ Squally winds speed reaching 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph is very likely to prevail over Southwest Arabian Sea. Sea condition is very likely to be rough to very rough over these areas. Fishermen are advised not to venture into the above mentioned areas.

♦ Squally winds 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph is likely to prevail over southwest Bay of Bengal and adjoining Equatorial India Ocean, along and off Tamilnadu coast, Gulf of Mannar, Palk Strait. Sea condition is very likely to be rough to very rough over these areas. Fishermen are advised not to venture into the above mentioned areas.

21 November (Day 3): ♦ Heavy to very heavy rain at isolated places very likely over Tamilnadu & Puducherry and **heavy rain** at isolated places over south Rayalaseema, South Interior Karnataka, south Coastal Andhra Pradesh and Kerala.

♦ Squally winds 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph is likely to prevail over southwest Bay of Bengal and adjoining Equatorial India Ocean, along and off Tamilnadu coast, Gulf of Mannar, Palk Strait. Sea condition is very likely to be rough to very rough over these areas. Fishermen are advised not to venture into the above mentioned areas.

22 November (Day 4): ♦ No weather warning.

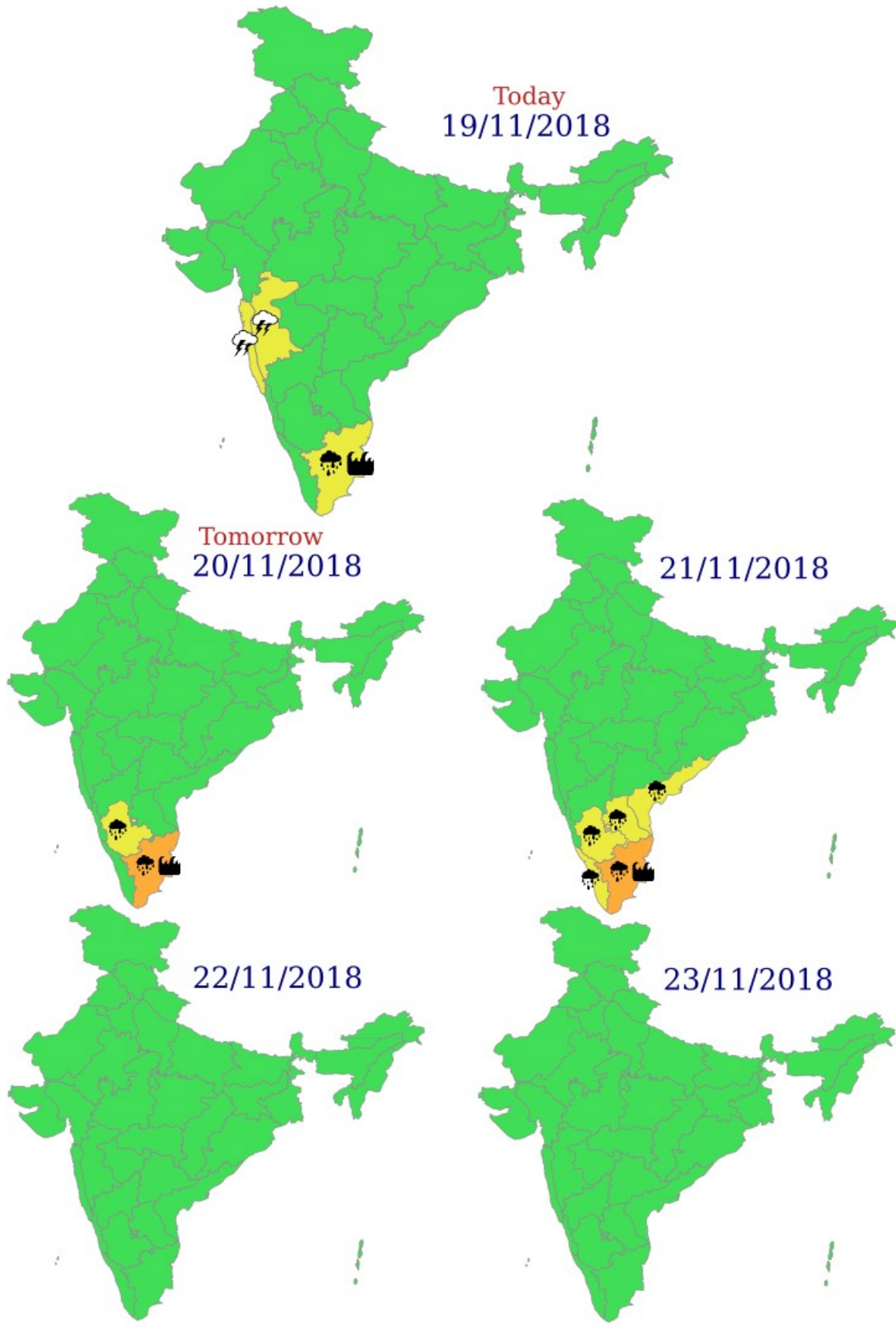

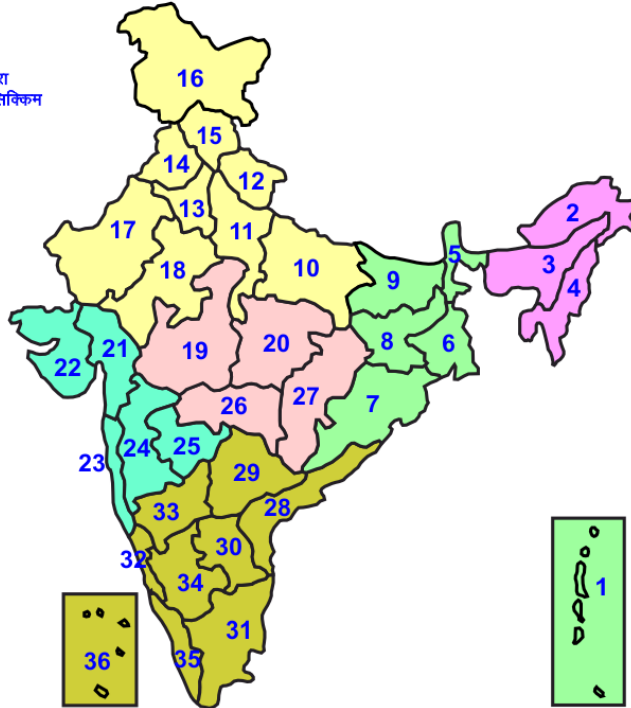
